
Not today, hackers.

R codes can be a quick and easy way to pay for parking...or steal customer data. If your pay-by-cell system uses QR codes printed on decals, your customers aren't safe. Hackers in multiple cities have replaced legitimate QR decals on parking meters with their own, nearly identical, counterfeit QR decals. Customers who scan these counterfeit decals are brought to a phony website (identical to the legitimate website) where they enter personal and financial information that can then be exploited. Google Pay. There's no app to download or account to create. Time purchased with POMPay appears on the parking meter just as it would if time
were purchased with coins or a credit card.

POMPay is designed to be as simple for parking operators as it is for customers. No signage or decals are required — all necessary information appears on the meter's screen. When meter rates are changed in MeterManager, POMPay rates are automatically updated to match. The best part is that there is no additional cost to use POMPay with POM Parktel meters.
